

Tubing FAQs

Do I need to complete a Snow Tubing Release Form?

Yes. Anyone tubing at Beach Mountain must complete and sign the Snow Tubing Release Form. This form must be signed by a parent/guardian for children under 18. Please click this [simple form](#) to download and bring with you to Beach Mountain.

How tall do you need to be to go down Beach Mountain?

All participants are required to be 42” tall in order to snow tube. A small tubing area is provided for anyone under 42” in the Play Area, which all children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian the entire time.

Can we tube longer than the original 2 hours?

Of course you can! You can add more time in increments of (1)hour for \$6 at the time of purchase OR \$10 after your session ends. [Find out more!](#)
